Please Note:

- In all cases, all course pre-requisites must be met.
- You must maintain a 2.0 GPA at Baruch to be allowed for future terms.
- You must submit an application for each term you wish to attend.
- You may only take 3 business courses your academic career as a non-degree student.

VISITING STUDENT (A NEW APPLICATION MUST BE FILED FOR EACH TERM YOU INTEND ON ENROLLING IN)

File this application if:

- You are currently enrolled in a non-CUNY college.
- You do not intend on enrolling in 4000 level or above Liberal Arts courses
- You do not intend on enrolling in the following business courses:
upper-level (3000 and above) ACC courses, BPL 5100, CIS 4350, CIS 4400, CIS 5800, 4000-level ECO courses,
upper-level (3000 and above) FIN courses, IBS 5750, 4000-level law courses, MGT 4500, MGT 4963, MKT 3000,
