Before declaring the business minor, students must complete BUS 2000 (or former BUS 1000/1001/1011). Eligibility to declare such a minor is restricted to students who have an overall GPA of 2.0 or more at the time they declare the minor. To be awarded the minor, students must have a GPA of 2.0 or more in the courses included in the minor.
